Afternoon Activities - First Term 2010

Activities start on Monday 01 February and finish in the week ending Friday 01 April.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- If your child is unable to attend an activity they have committed to, please inform the teacher/instructor in advance.
- The Library will no longer be used as an area for the supervision of students who are not involved in afternoon activities. However, Junior students who need to use the Library for quiet reading or research, are welcome to do so in the afternoon.
- We urge you not to leave your child/ren at school if they are not involved in afternoon activities.**
- We urge you to collect your child directly after his/her last activity. We do appreciate that it can be difficult at times for working parents to take children home at lunch time or immediately after an activity. However, we would like to stress that we do not provide after-school care or a child-minding service.
- Infant (Std 1 & 2) students** will be supervised on Mondays & Wednesdays from 2.00pm-5.00pm in the Reception Playground area at the Reception Block.
- Infant children staying at lunchtime **must** be supervised by a parent.
- There is a teacher on duty during the afternoons from Monday-Thursday. There is no supervision for students after 5.30pm. Students who are not collected by 5.30pm will be sent to wait in front of the Office.

INFANT AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES for Standard 1 and Standard 2

This term we continue to offer a variety of activities for the Std 1s and 2s on a Monday afternoon. Each child will experience four activities for six weeks and then a different four activities for the remaining five weeks. These activities take place from 2.00 pm until 4.00pm on a Monday and your child is required at school for that period of time. All children are to be in the Reception Playground area at the Reception Block at 2.00pm, to ensure that we have organised movement to activities. This format:

- Allows each child to experience more and varied activities.
- Ensures that participation in a certain activity will not be limited due to numbers.
- Allows for better organisation and supervision of activities.
- Allows each child to work within the same group for the duration of each of the five/six week activity cycles.

In addition, the Std 1s and 2s will have the opportunity to attend Infant Choir on a Monday between 1.30pm and 2.00pm, as well as swimming on a Wednesday afternoon between 2pm and 4pm.
